LOCAL FAVORITES

Basalt Cellars ~ Clarkston

Merlot \$38 bottle

Aromas of cherries, blackberries, kirsch, vanilla, toast, and leather offer an inviting welcome. The lively acidity serves up pie cherries, plums, cocoa powder and licorice.

Cabernet \$43 per bottle

On the nose you will find blackberries and black licorice with a hint of oak. The palate will produce a touch of coffee, leather and toast.

Lemberger \$25 per bottle

Aromas of cherry pie, strawberry soda, cinnamon and vanilla make this a sensory delight. Taste lively fruit with a long finish.

Merry Cellars ~ Pullman

Crimson \$34 per bottle

Ripe fruit meets mouth filling layers of chocolate, currant and spice. Well balanced acidity and tannin deliver the promise of ageability along with immediate drinkability.

2006 Syrah \$20 per bottle

Juicy layers of ripe fruit, raspberry and cassis, concentration and firm tannins support a full but well balanced mouth feel and a long, supple finish.

RED WINE

Merlot

Bogle Vineyards \$5 per glass \$16 per bottle

Graton, CA. Tastes of dark plum, tart black cherry and mocha with hints of cedar, vanilla and mild toasty oak.

Gato Negro \$14 per bottle

California. Dry, medium intensity red wine, with lots of delicious raspberry and black cherry flavors.

Three Rivers \$28 per bottle

Columbia Valley, WA. This beautifully balanced merlot has cocoa, black cherry, and vanilla characteristics.

Red Rock \$18 per bottle

California. Lush concentrations of black cherry, plum and boysenberry are complemented by soft round tannins.

Waterbrook \$32 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. Inviting aromas of candied violets, cigar box and black cherries. Tantalizing rich fruit marries with warm notes of cedar and spice leaving soft tannins lingering.

Columbia Crest H3 \$22 per bottle

Paterson, WA. The H3 Merlot entices the nose with aromas of blueberry, cassis and hints of tobacco and spice aromas. The silky and sweet mid-palate introduces slight dusty, earthy, and rich berry notes which cumulate in the long and concentrated finish.

Syrah/Shiraz

Canyon's Edge \$20 per bottle

Prosser, WA. Strawberry aromas on the nose with a fruity, medium body. Tart white strawberry, cream and spice flavor.

Barnard Griffin \$22 per bottle

Tri-Cities, WA. Plum, raspberry, and blackberry are showcased. Discreet, spicy wood notes add complexity. Solid acidity enlivens the lengthy finish.

Layer Cake \$22 per bottle

South Australia. Dark, dense and creamy, complex aromas of black plum, Bing cherry, blackberry and pepper merge with licorice, tobacco, mocha and dark chocolate.

Rose

Barnard Griffin Rose of Sangiovese \$15 per bottle

Tri-Cities, WA. A dry Sangiovese Rose tour de force! Boasts a range of complex flavors built around racy strawberry and tart orange with hints of melon rind and peach.

Malbec

Milbrandt \$28 per bottle

Washington State. The aromatics are an intense mix of Bing cherries, jam, blueberries, chocolate, plums and vanilla. The palate is lush, supple and velvety.

Conquista \$14 per bottle

Argentina. Layers of blackberries and blueberries, hints of mocha and spice, full bodied with with good acidity

Tomero \$19 per bottle

Intense violet red color. Aromas of fresh plums, dry figs and vanilla. In the mouth it has a sweet entrance, with good structure and long finish

Cabernet

Cellar No. 8 \$16 per bottle

Sonoma, CA. Shows tobacco, bing cherries, leather and a hint of strawberry on the nose. The finish is silky smooth with a bit of pepper.

Eliseo Silva \$14 per bottle

Othello, WA. Rich black cherry, pomegranate with a trace of black teas, leather and chocolate.

Rock and Vine \$6 per glass \$22 per bottle

Napa Valley, CA. Brooding nose of fruit opens slowly to show pretty French Oak, toasty mocha and high-toned blueberry fruit.

Sebastiani \$25 per bottle

Sonoma County, CA. Features flavors of black cherry and cranberries. Merlot, Petite Verdot and Malbec blended in. Also included is Petite Syrah to add complexity and tannin.

Waterbrook \$30 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. Layered aromatics of cedar, cola, pencil lead and black cherry develop in the glass. Rich flavors of black currant, strawberry, nutmeg and vanilla marry on the palate.

L'Ecole No. 41 \$42 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. Boasts rich black cherries, dark currant and orange spice flavors, with hints of toasted oak and moderate tannins.

Ghost Pines \$25 per bottle

Sonoma, CA. Aromas of sweet nuts, sweet aromatics and black pepper complement the dark fruit aromas and flavors of this curvaceous wine. The palate is dense and chewy without being overly astringent.

Beringer Knights Valley \$32 per bottle

Napa Valley, CA. Inky black with a garnet rim. Shy aromas of plum and leather. Creamy flavors of blackberry and blueberry. Velvety tannins and hints of maple and vanilla in the blackberry-infused close.

Port

Barnard Griffin Syrah \$8 per glass \$21 per bottle

Tri-Cities, WA. Just a whiff of chocolaty, toasty wood gives way to fabulous aromas of cherry and raspberry. Richly-fruited and thickly layered, boasting a stylish streak of blueberry fruit.

Pivot Noir

Cycles Gladiator \$15 per bottle

California. Signature ripe black cola and a hint of spiciness on the nose. Flavors of cherry, plum, wild berries and vanilla fill the mouth.

Erath \$25 per bottle

Dundee, OR. Dark cherry and mocha aromas in the nose, with deep black cherry, plum and spice flavors on the palate. Firm tannin create a bold, sensational finish.

Zinfandel

Seven Deadly Zins' \$22 per bottle

Lodi, CA. Sweet plums and pepper dominate the nose while flavors of blueberry, raspberry, cinnamon and black pepper pack the palate from start to finish.

Ghost Pines \$25 per bottle

Sonoma, CA. Opening with bright flavors of strawberry jam and ripe plum, and aromas of vanilla bean and mocha. Full and balanced, our Zinfandel boasts rich, chewy tannins that lead to a long and supple finish.

Sledgehammer \$6 per glass \$18 per bottle

Dark, ripe fruit and surprising complexity make it wise beyond its years. When you take a sledgehammer to Zin grapes, you get intensely ripe and intense flavor that's a hammer blow to your taste buds.

Red Blends

Goose Ridge g3 \$20 per bottle

Columbia Valley, WA. Blackberry and dark cherry flavors blend with vanilla and toasty oak to create a round intense mouthful.

Waterbrook Melange \$20 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. Ripe and plump, generous with its spicy, mocha-scented cherry and blackberry flavors, persisting smoothly through the long, harmonious finish.

Bookwalter \$30 per bottle

Richland, WA. Aromas of black olive, plum, Bing cherries and vanilla. On the palate it is sweet, almost caramel like and finishes with spice, black cherries and silky lush tannins.

Alexander Nicole Quarry Butte \$30 per bottle

Columbia Valley, WA. Ripe berry flavors, hints of elegant oak and spice that lead to a balanced structure and lengthy finish.

Northstar Stella Maris \$32 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. Huge nose of roasting espresso bean and mocha, flavors of black cherry, red currant, with layers of vanilla, clove and chocolate.

Uriah \$70 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. A nose of complex dark fruit with hints of cedar, crushed stone and dry herbs leads into, licorice and black cherry on the palate.

Cougar Crest Anniversary Cuvee \$50 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. With a backbone of Cabernet and the full bodied mid-palate of Merlot are given added complexity and density with the addition of Petit Verdot and Malbec.

14 Hands Hot to Trot \$5 per glass \$16 per bottle

Paterson, WA. Generous aromas of ripe berries and dark stone fruits open this ruby-hued wine. Fleshy flavors of cherries and plum are met with soft and velvety tannins, finishing with a hint of mocha.

L'Ecole No 41 Apogee \$65 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. Apogee was the first wine produced from Pepper Bridge Vineyard and shows its characteristic spicy, bold and dark fruit flavors with a rich structure, well-integrated tannins and a long finish.

Fidelitas M-100 \$28 per bottle

Columbia Valley, WA. A blend of Cabernet and Merlot, nice fleshy mouth feel, with plum and black fruit flavors, hints of pie spice, undercurrent of cedar and smoky finely delineated tannins.

WHITE WINE

Blush & White Blend

Beringer White \$10 per bottle

Napa Valley, CA. Highlighting the fresh red berry, citrus and melon aromas and flavors, rounded out with subtle hints of nutmeg and clove.

14 Hands Hot to Trot \$16 per bottle

Paterson, WA. Aromas of bright apple are joined by subtle notes of white flowers, vanilla and butter. On the palate, juicy pear complements touches of sweet oak and spice, and ends with a soft and lingering finish.

Reisling

Kung Fu Girl \$17 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. Delicate aromas of stone fruit, white peach, apricot, Asian pear and white spring blossoms. Long and layered.

A to Z \$20 per bottle

Dundee, OR. Fresh aromas of slate lime, white flowers, minerals and citrus. Complex nuances of strawberries, orange blossom and spice emerge on the palate, all ending with a crisp, clean finish.

Pacific Rim \$5 per glass \$17 per bottle

Columbia Valley, WA. Portraying bright crispness, subtle sweetness and aromas of jasmine, pear and apple, the wine exemplifies the harmony of reisling.

Sauvignon Blanc

Mohua \$6 per glass \$20 per bottle

New Zealand. Fresh pear and candied lemon aromas and flavors remain fresh and zingy through the finish in this lively white.

Oyster Bay \$20 per bottle

New Zealand. Fragrant tropical and floral notes with vibrant fresh lime and citrus zest, a fine texture and an intense crisp finish

Chardonnay

Gordon Brothers \$6 per glass \$20 per bottle

Columbia Valley, WA. Flavors of vanilla, burnt caramel and hazelnut, this wine feels like a dessert in a glass.

Barnard Griffin \$17 per bottle

Tri-Cities, WA. Fragrant tangerine and lime with discreet wood-spice notes. A mouthful of explosive fruit flavors that go on and on.

'O' \$24 per bottle

Horse Heaven Hills, WA. Liveliness and ripe, fruit flavors make this wine an ideal compliment for wide variety of food.

Waterbrook \$20 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. Aromatic green apple and citrus zest married with tropical fruit notes. Grapefruit and apple with hints of toast lead to a wonderful, bright finish.

Pinot Grigio

Maryhill \$5 per glass \$16 per bottle

Columbia Valley, WA. Lively notes of soft apple, peach and pear. On the palate the peach becomes deeper with rich flavors of nectarine and subtle pineapple, leading the fresh clean apple finish.

A to Z \$20 per bottle

Dundee, OR. Rich and ripe gold coloring with beautiful emerald flashes. Powerful ripe citrus fruits, acacia flowers, lychee, powdered sugar, honeysuckle, nectarines and pineapple flavors that last forever.

Seven Hills \$22 per bottle

Walla Walla, WA. The wine is lemon-straw in color with aromas of ripe pear, mint and vanillin. There's just a hint of butterscotch from the oak. The wine is dry, but has a bright, sweet fruit palate made more interesting by a hint of spearmint by mouth.

Sparkling Wine & Champagne

Segura Viudas \$15 per bottle

Spain. Fairly crisp with an interesting floral note and mouth-pleasing sensation of creaminess.

Ballatorre Rosso Red Spumante \$15 per bottle

Modesto, CA. Inviting blackberry and citrus aroma combined with a vibrant ruby color make this a truly captivating sparkling wine that is rich in characteristics.

Lunesta Prosecco \$16 per bottle

Trentino, Italy. Lunetta, ("Little Moon" in Italian) celebrates life's small pleasures. Fragrant, with enticing aromas of apples and peach.
